

# Yealink – Phone Web Interface Issue

When attempting to login to the telephones web interface `https://xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx` a message displays “Your connection is not private. This is due to Yealink using a self signed certificate which is not trusted by the browser.

## Option1

Using Chrome as an example, with the browser page showing an Advanced Button.

1. Click the Advanced Button

You will not see the word being typed on the screen  
3. The browser window will open to the Yealink login page.
